All of the letters seem to be referring to famous songs, with snippets of the original lyrics incorporated into the songs. Google searching can yield the following songs:

<b>Song Name</b>	<b>Songwriter</b>
Going to California	Robert Plant (Led Zeppelin)
Graceland	Paul Simon
Hey Jude	Paul McCartney
You're So Vain	Carly Simon
Don't Think Twice, It's All Right	Bob Dylan
Man on the Moon	Michael Stipe (REM)

We can confirm our choices by noting that the songwriters' first names are the writers of the puzzle letters.

The blanks in the addressee fields seem to imply that we want to find who the letters were addressed to, or rather who the songs were addressed to. Investigating further into the songs tells us that each song was written about a specific person.

<b>Song Name</b>	<b>Addressee</b>
Going to California	Joni Mitchell
Graceland	Carrie Fisher
Hey Jude	Julian Lennon
You're So Vain	Warren Beatty
Don't Think Twice, It's All Right	Suze Rotolo
Man on the Moon	Andy Kaufman

Next, we notice that each letter has a month embedded, which is not part of the song lyrics. Each month is associated with a number, which we can use to index into the addressee names:

<b>Addressee</b>	<b>Month</b>	<b>Indexed Letter</b>
Joni Mitchell	January (1)	J
Carrie Fisher	May (5)	I
Julian Lennon	March (3)	L
Warren Beatty	November (11)	T
Suze Rotolo	April (4)	E
Andy Kaufman	March (3)	D

so the final answer is **JILTED**.
