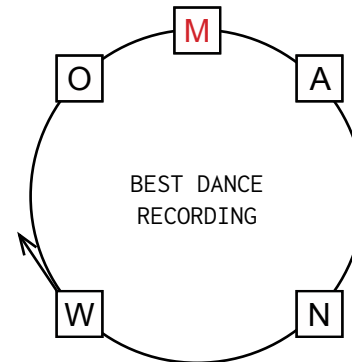
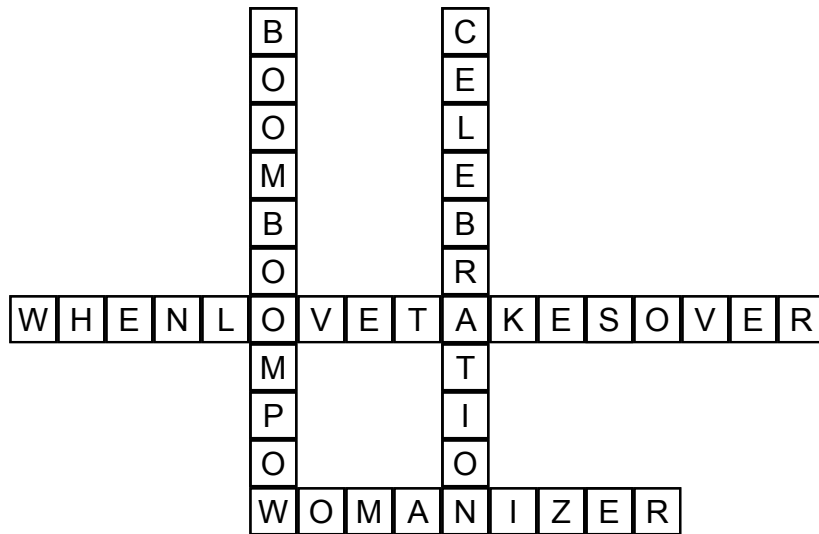
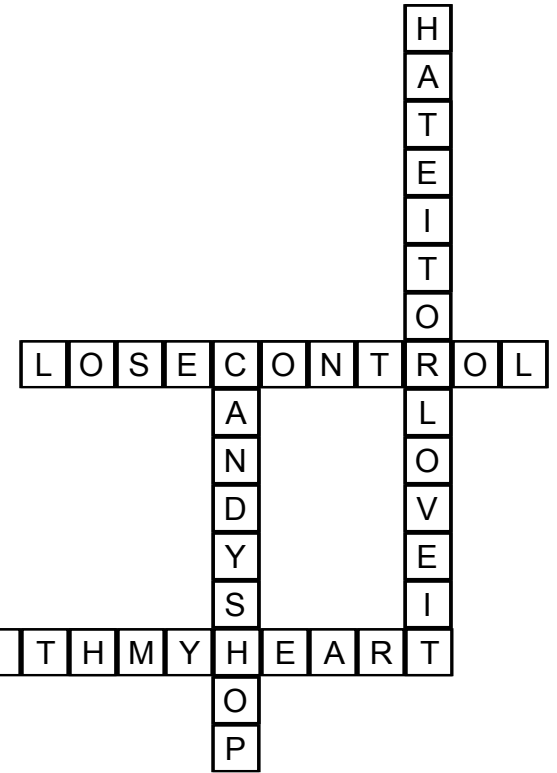
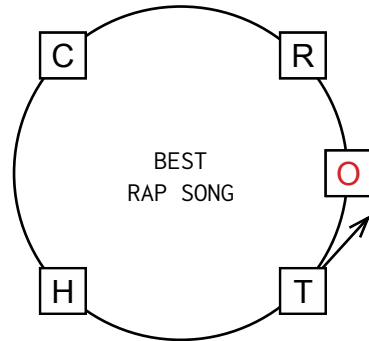
These nominees fit uniquely in each crossword setup.
